Using the text of Little Red Riding Hood we will look at what makes a Fairy Tale and use this to write our own Jack and the Beanstalk stories.



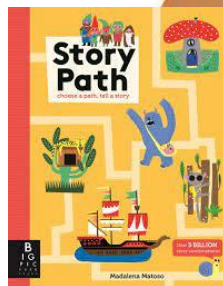
Mixed Up Fairy Tales
